Clinic End-of-Year Reminders ...

*** Medication Pick-Up between 830am-230pm Daily***

If your child has medication in the clinic, it must be picked up BEFORE 1pm on Thursday, June 15. Any medications that have not been picked up by that time will be discarded per Regulation 757-4. Please remember that NEW treatment plans/medication forms are required EVERY year. *** Tdap, Meningitis and HPV vaccines REQUIRED for rising 7th Graders***

The deadline to meet immunization requirements for the upcoming school year is **August 17, 2023**. Parents/guardians may view information about student compliance with required immunizations in ParentVUE. To see what immunizations your child is missing, simply go into the ParentVue app, click on your child's name, then the health tab, then immunizations and this will show what immunizations are still needed.

Please email the updated immunization record as soon as possible to the nurse and registrar (johnsot1@pwcs.edu & raymonjd@pwcs.edu) or send a hard copy in with your child.
